I am writing to you to ask you to reconsider the 50% rate increase that I am

being asked to pay as a Sunset Scavenger customer in San Francisco.

I have been a dedicated recycler for decades. I have enclosed a recent bill to

show you that I already have the bare minimum storage capacity bins that you provide.

I requested this myself long before this rate increase was on the table. Every week, my

20 gallon black bin is not even 25% full. My blue bin is usually full, and I keep my own

garden compost for gardening, so my 32 gallon green bin has even less than my black

bin, unless I am doing a lo† of yard work. Then my green bin is full of weeds maybe

10 pick-ups per year. My garbage could be picked up every other week and it still

wouldn't be full. I will be reducing my black bin to the 16 gallon size.

I do not feel it's fair to charge me 50% more more something I already do over

and above what you are trying to get everyone else to do. It feels like I am being

penalized.

I have also been and continue to be diligent about taking anything and every-

thing I can to places like SCRAP who re-use items that most people throw out, such $% \left(1\right) =\left(1\right) +\left(1\right)$

as wine bottle cork caps, styrofoam chips, baskets, plastic flower pots, etc. instead of

filling up by black bin with such things.

I have also been an avid water recycler even before the drought. I had a grey

water system installed. My water bill \$20.00/month is well below the

conservation target for individuals. For years before the drought, I saved my

bath and shower water and syphoned it out to water my garden in dry periods. I do

this not to save money, but because I believe in the power and need to reduce our

waste of resources.

Thank you for the opportunity to weigh in and voice my concern, and I hope you

will reconsider overcharging consumers like myself. I do understand the bigger

picture and support a zero-waste garbage target. But a 50% rate increase is way too

much too fast, especially for those of us who already have greatly reduced our waste.
