Dear Mr. Arsenault,

Thank you for the proposal that Recology has submitted to Public Works for review and approval for improvements to the Recycle Central Facility. As approved in the 2013 rate hearing by the Refuse Collection and Disposal Rate Board, Recology can propose projects to the City to increase diversion if it does not qualify for the Tier 3 and 4 Zero Waste Incentives in a given Rate Year. Proposals must provide a detailed budget, timeline, and the projected increase in diversion, and be reviewed and approved by the Directors of the Department of the Environment and the Department of Public Works.

The two tables below summarize your proposed budget and the estimated increase in diversion as follows:

Based on this analysis and the additional information in your proposal, I approve the use of Tier 3 and 4 incentive funds from FY 13/14 and FY 14/15. The use of incentive funds from FY15/16 cannot be considered until the close of that rate year because we cannot determine whether the funds will be available. But Recology can apply to use the incentive funds after the close of the rate year if it is determined that it did not meet the diversion targets required to earn the incentives.
