Dear Mr. Nuru,

In accordance with Recology's proposal, submitted December 8, 2015, for the Recycle Central® Material Recovery Facility Upgrade and subsequent letter of approval from Public Works, dated January 29, 2016, Recology is requesting the approval to use Rate Year 2016 (RY16) Tier 3 & 4 Zero Waste Incentive funds for the second phase of project construction. For Rate Year 2016 the Tier 1 diversion target tonnage goal was 355,980 tons and Recology disposed of 412,000 tons. Since Recology did not meet the year's diversion targets, we are requesting approval to apply the RY16 Tier 3 & 4 incentive funds, equaling \$3,200,550.50, to the Recycle Central® project.

Additionally, Recology previously received approval for the use of \$463,452 from the RY14 incentive funds for our Textile Program. This program was successfully rolled out and completed utilizing only \$247,597 of those approved funds. So in addition to the above request to use the RY16 Tier 3 & 4 incentive funds, Recology is requesting that the remaining \$215,855 Textile Program funds also be applied to the second phase of the Recycle Central® project construction. The remaining costs to complete the upgrade will be funded by Recology.

Exhibit A details the Zero Waste Incentives Account Balance as of July 31, 2016 and below is a table summarizing the requested Recycle Central \*project funding:
