




# Safer Taylor Street

Pedestrian Safety Project


# FYI



**Project Limits:** Taylor Street between Turk Street and Ellis Street

**Project benefits:** The project will enrich the experience for residents, businesses and visitors, making the area safer and more attractive for pedestrians, motorists and Muni riders in the neighborhood.

**Project highlights:** The scope of work will include sidewalk widening, curb bulb-outs, new traffic signals, upgraded striping at crosswalks and streetscape amenities.



Quick Build safety improvements implemented in Summer 2019, including signal timing adjustments, intersection daylighting and enhanced crosswalk and intersection striping were implemented while the team continued to coordinate among the various city agencies to finalize detailed design and construction plans.

**Construction Schedule**  
March 2022 through March 2024

**Project Team:** San Francisco Public Works in partnership with the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency.

**Construction impacts:** Work will have some impacts on traffic and parking. Sidewalk access will also be impacted. The contractor will take steps necessary to minimize the impact of construction.

Please allow extra travel time during construction work hours. Also, please be sure to check the posted "No Parking/Tow Away" signs (posted on construction barricades) for precise work hours because they may vary depending on the construction task and location.

**Note:** Cars can be towed at the owners expense if parked within work areas posted with valid "No Parking/ Tow Away" signs.
