Construction Schedule January 2022 through January 2024


Please allow extra travel time during construction work hours. Also, please be sure to check the posted "No Parking/Tow Away" signs (posted on construction barricades) for precise work hours because they may vary depending on the construction task and location. **Note: Cars can be towed at the owners expense if parked within work areas posted with valid "No Parking/ Tow Away" signs.**

Project benefits: The project will enrich the experience for residents, businesses and visitors, making the area safer and more attractive for pedestrians, motorists and Muni riders in the neighborhood.

Project highlights: The scope of work will include sidewalk widening, curb bulb-outs, new traffic signals, upgraded striping at crosswalks and streetscape amenities.

Construction impacts: Work will have some impacts on traffic and parking. Sidewalk access will also be impacted. The contractor will take steps necessary to minimize the impact of construction.

Construction will primarily take place along 6th Street between Market & Howard streets.
